Dear Parents and carers,

This is just a reminder letter to say that our year 3 and 4 classes will be swimming on **Wednesday afternoons between 1.30pm and 3pm for 11 weeks commencing Wednesday 12<sup>th</sup> January with the final session taking place on Wednesday 30<sup>th</sup> March.** These lessons will be led by two qualified swimming instructors.

Thank you to those parents and carers who have already made the voluntary contribution towards the swimming lessons.

However, as already stated in the previous letter, swimming may **not** be possible **unless** we receive enough contributions towards the cost of swimming lessons. In order for swimming lessons to take place, **we require £2.73 per session or a total of £30.00 for the 11 sessions. Our preference would be for the £30 payment to be paid before 14<sup>th</sup> January.** Each swimming lesson must be paid for in advance, even if paying weekly. We are happy to receive instalments of any amount in advance of each weekly swimming lesson.

**Any arrears have to be funded by the school at the cost of any other learning resources.**

You can pay online via ParentPay (the web based system we currently use to pay for school meals). We hope you will support us in enabling our children to have swimming in every year group.

If you would like to make an additional contribution to the school to support any individual families who are finding it difficult to make the payment, then please speak to Mrs Suzie James or Mrs Ria Cruttenden in the school office, as we would like as many children to be able to swim as possible.

**On Wednesdays, please ensure your children have the following in school:**

- **swimming costume/trunks**
- **Large towel**
- **Hair band for long hair or a swimming cap if preferred.**
- **ALL JEWELLERY MUST BE REMOVED OR SECURED SAFELY.**

**If you have a child in Orcas class, please collect any siblings from school first as this will allow an additional 5-10 minutes for the children to get changed.**

**All children from Orcas class will need to be picked up from the swimming pool at 3:10pm. Children from Barracudas and Cuttlefish class will be picked up as normal from the playground.**
